
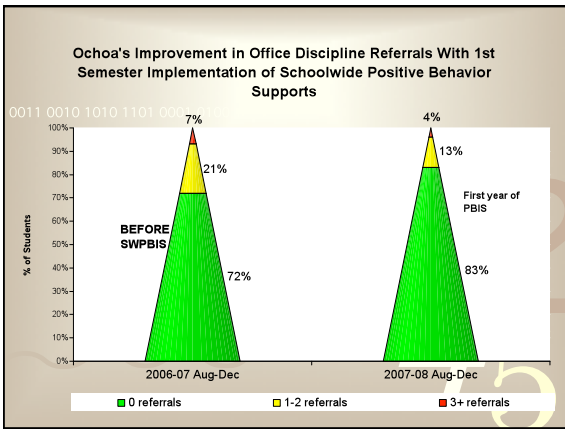


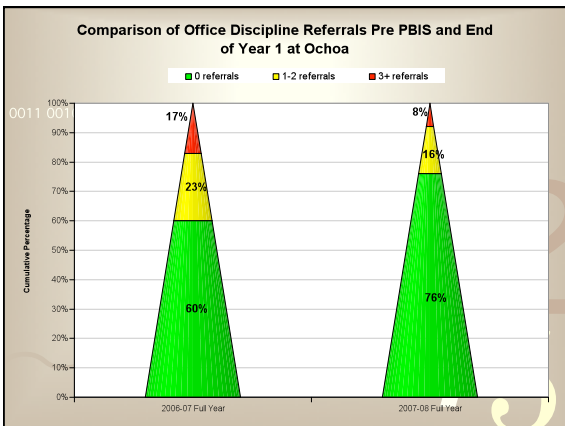
Display Your Discipline Data in the Tier Triangle

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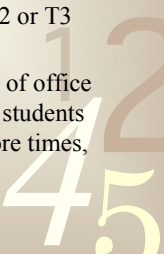




How to create your triangle:

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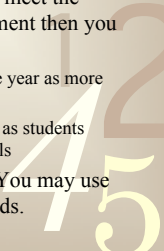
- The tiers are frequency counts of the number of students in the T1, T2 or T3 category
- It is not reflective of the number of office referrals – but of the number of students who have been referred 3 or more times, 1-2 times or not at all



Facts about this method of data view

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- Because the percentage of students in each tier is a frequency count of students who meet the criteria divided by the total enrollment then you will see:
 1. less green as you progress through the year as more students get one or more referrals
 2. Growth of the Tier 2 and 3 categories as students receive more office discipline referrals
- The triangle is a snapshot in time. You may use it to compare two equal time periods.

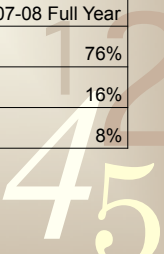


Using Excel to create the Graph

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- Create your table as follows:

	2006-07 Full Year	2007-08 Full Year
0 referrals	60%	76%
1-2 referrals	23%	16%
3+ referrals	17%	8%



Create a Chart / Graph

- Use chart wizard and select the cone or pyramid from the standard list
- Select the 100% stacked column option
- Click next and select "rows" at the bottom of the next box
- At this point you can give your graph a title, format the legend, and select the tab called "data labels" and make sure to check the box next to "value"
- save your new chart/graph in it's own worksheet
